



TENNIS BEGINNERS, AND THOSE RETURNING TO THE GAME






Tennis is a great game, but better and more enjoyable when played well. Warwick Boat Club can help learners to become better more quickly, and have a lot of fun along the way.

Our combination of group sessions and coaching opportunities are designed to make sure you have a great time on the tennis court. Some of it is about technique and some about meeting other like-minded people who will support you. Better club players come to the club's renowned mix-in sessions where the club manager, or a coach, picks players of similar abilities to play one set at a time (usually doubles games). Mix-in players are capable of serving consistently, playing ground strokes and volleys reliably and have a good understanding of tennis rules and etiquette.

LEARN TO PLAY PATHWAY:

- Saturday group coaching sessions at 1.15pm until 2.15pm. They are timed to align with Saturday mix-in, thereby involving people in club life during a busy period and helping them see the standard at mix-in. Courses run from 1st March to 31st October and cost £95 for all the sessions (£50 if joining on or after 1st July)
- Thursday 11am-12:30pm beginners' course as part of the group coaching programme
- Weekday evening courses available through the club group coaching programme
- Individual lessons with club-registered coaches, available if a beginner member wishes
