Events are subject to sufficient entries.

Where necessary Senior and Mixed events will be split into bands of crews with similar ranking index. The winners of each band will receive glass tankards.

Masters events will be combined where necessary and the appropriate age handicap applied. Masters without competition may be moved to an appropriate senior event. Please tell us if you don't want to be moved.

Subject to entry J12, J13, J14 and Primary events with 3 or more entries will be run as leagues with competitors racing at least twice. In order to give the youngest juniors more racing J12 events will be offered in Open only.

The Warwick Goblets are awarded on a 2 year cycle, the top female sculler one year and the top male sculler the next year.

Competitors may enter one event per division. No doubling up of crews/coxes or equipment within a division.

Primary Events

These events are intended for newcomers new to the sport. They are open to competitors over the age of 18 that started rowing or sculling within the last 12 months. Participants must be registered members of British Rowing and may not enter an open event at the regatta. Events with 3 or more entries will be run as leagues with competitors racing at least twice.



Entries £10.50 per seat

All entries and payments to be made using BROE2.

Entries close at 8pm on Thursday 8th August.

The draw will take place at 25 Coventry Road, Warwick at 12 noon on Saturday 10th August.
