The regatta is being run as a Primary Regatta so all events are non qualifying.

Primary events (N, IM3, J13, J14 & J15) with 3 or more entries will be run as leagues with competitors racing at least twice.

Non primary events (IM2 status and above and Masters) are restricted to clubs from the West Midlands and neighbouring regions only (North West, East Midlands, Thames, WAGS, Wales).

New Rower Events are open to anyone that has been rowing or sculling for less than 1 year and has not yet raced at a BR Head or Regatta. Events with 3 or more entries will be run as leagues with competitors racing at least twice.

Doubling up is permitted at competitors' own risk. No trebling up.

Warwick Boat Club reserves the right to limit the number of entries and to invoice clubs that make a formal entry and then fail to attend.
